


Round up 3

In each short episode, a hilarious Jonathan interviews an expert on a range of topics, from serious (such as slavery) to fun (such as interviewing his queer eye co-star about his life). High Low Low In this hugely popular podcast, witty, whip-smart journalists Dolly Alderton and Pandora Sykes delve deep into the issues of the week, whether it's the latest political scandal or a hilarious viral meme. Always very smart and often very funny, it's a great way to keep on top of the headlines of the week. Gripping storytellingThis American Life This American Life Award-winning weekly radio show, which is heard by 2.2 million people on more than 500 stations, is also available for download as a podcast. Hosted by Ira Glass, each episode focuses on one topic, providing one long story or multiple stories. The themes are varied and broad: from people who went on a mission to save young girls from danger to focus in detail on the unrest in Hong Kong. The show has been running for almost 20 years, so there are many episodes to choose from. Serial series from the creators of this American life, the serial unfolds one true story during the season. Hosted by Sarah Koenig, the show follows the plot and characters where they lead, through many amazing twists - and even Sarah doesn't know what's going on at the end of the story until she gets there. Teacher Pet Teachers Pet If you are drawn into shocking stories of true crime like Netflix's Making a Murderer, then this 2018 podcast series will be missed. The Australian podcast investigates the disappearance of mother Lynette Dawson in 1982, revealing flaws in a criminal investigation with many twists and turns along the way. From famous names like Jennifer Lopez and Dwayne Johnson, to well-being experts and thought-leaders, each episode is illuminated and invigorated. Happy Mom, Happy Baby with Giovanna Fletcher Giovanna Fletcher Giovanna podcast covers all motherhood (and fatherhood) with a stellar array of guests, including Rochelle Humes, Nadya Hussain, Emma Willis and Instagram sensation, Father Daughters (Simon Hooper). Covering all aspects of parenting from pregnancy to parenting to adolescents to less talked about topics such as miscarriage and IVF, each episode is deeply personal and relatable.
